Each month a winner for each category will be chosen, biannual will be winner of monthly winner, grant goes to winner of biannual peach awards

Valdosta: Each category has one winner?

Recognitions: Each category has one winner monthly and those are eligible for Bi-annual.

GT: Who gets the grant, the individual, or the institution?

Recognitions: Working out between individual and institutions, I recognize the problem.

Committee with three people from three institutions to review winners, and proposal.

Georgian Southern: Would you like to talk about the difference between yearly awards and Peach awards?

Recognitions: Bid for those, but the committee meets for peach award monthly.

Director: Awards similar to before the constitutional revisions, bid specific. Peach

GT: Can you post constitution?

Director: It has gone out over the listserv. There are two facebook groups, Joseph will be the new administrator for one, and the other will not be used; they will be updated by the end of this week. Facebook group for GRHO with current board and constitution.

Website

The Exec Board doesn't really have knowledge, but they are working with others. SAACURH owns website for state affiliations; the Director will be contacting Jill for access to website. None of the information on the website is correct. From website, there will be a link to the awards and applications. Before opening questions, projects for future:

GRHO cheer book: NCCs can always have the handbook for SAACURH preparation. There will be guidelines as preparation for SAACURH to keep NCCs in the state on the same page to represent state of Georgia. If not on listserv, please come see the Director; for the Recognitions committee, the Recognitions Coordinator.

GT: Can we see an updated affiliations list?

Director: There is no official list. We can send a list of those who attended GRHO. The constitution has no definition of member school. If an institution attends GRHO with the registration fee, you are a member.

Joseph: Majority of present institutions were at GRHO.

Administrative Coordinator: Constitutionally wrong to restructure legislation over the listserv. It has to be done at a conference with two weeks notice prior.

Georgia Southern: Not many benefits currently available. No nonmembers because there nothing to offer to entice affiliation.

GT: Chicken and egg problem.

Georgia Southern: We had no money this year. Fun times
