GRHO 2010 Update: Georgia Southwestern

- Registration open now online; \$75 per delegate and \$90 per advisor
- Submit programs by January 15th
- Theme: Go Go Gadget GRHO
- Hotel: Jameson Inn, Americus check-in
- Delegate cap: 8 delegates and 1 advisor
- Registration deadline: December 12th

Affiliation/fees

- Starting in 2010, you must affiliate with GRHO
- Large schools pay \$50 (2,000 plus residents); Small schools pay \$25 (less than 2,000 residents)
- Mirrors the NACURH process
- Benefits: allocating money from fees for conference/program grants. Voice in GRHO boardroom
- Affiliate up until the conference or at the conference

Peach Awards

- State OTMs; recognition on the state level
- Opportunity to check your OTMs before regional submission
- Due on the 25th of each month
- Committee will review, pick winners, and give feedback

Officer positions

- Will change terms of office from NACURH to NACURH instead of GRHO to GRHO
- Current board will stay in office an extra five months
- Give more time for transition

Goals for the State:
